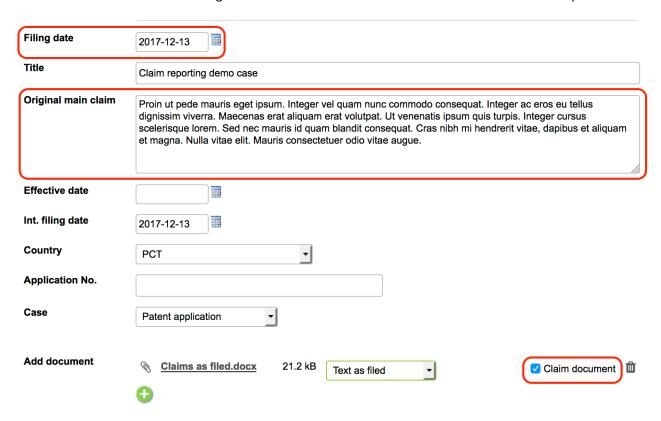
Reporting patent claims via Greip Reporting Interface

Claims can be reported in Filing report, Office action report, Grant report and Opposition/Appeal report.

Once the report is accepted the claim information is saved on case record in a separate tab *Claims history*. Claims are editable also directly on the case record.

Filing report

To report the claims in filing report, fill in Original main claim – field. Mark the document which contains the filed claims with the tick box. Filing date is used as the date when the claims were filed in the patent office.



Information saved according to the Filing report

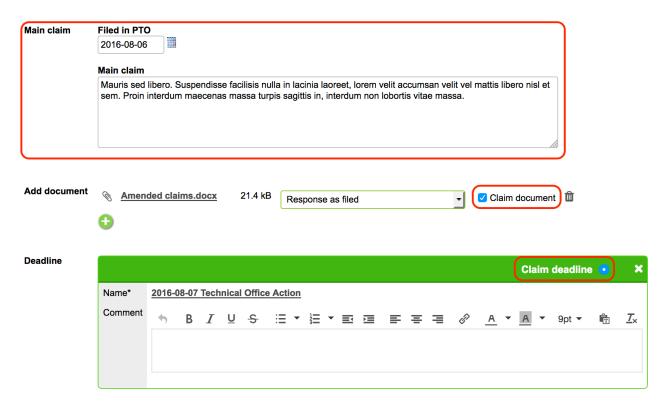
Claims are saved in *Claims history* tab on case record.

Filing date is marked as the date when claims were filed in the patent office. The main claim reported in the filing report is marked to be the Originally filed version of the main claim. The document marked as Claim document is linked to the version to have easy access to the complete set of claims.

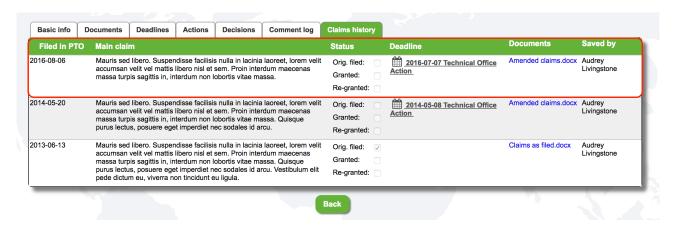


Office action response

To report the claims in Office action report, fill in the Main claim -field and the date when amended claims were filed in the patent office. Mark the document which contains the filed claims with the tick box. Select the deadline where the amended claims are related to.

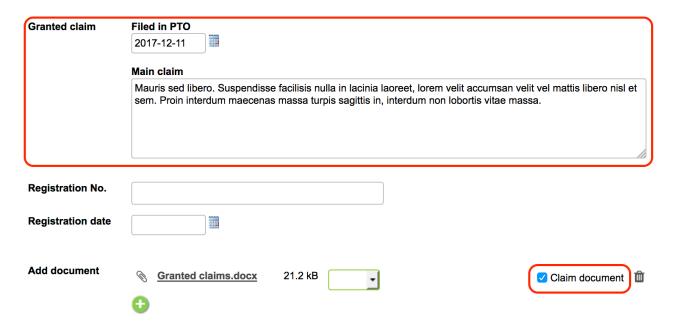


Information saved according to the Office action report



Grant report

To report the claims in Grant report, fill in the Main claim -field and the date when amended claims were filed in the patent office. Mark the document which contains the filed claims with the tick box.



Information saved according to the Grant report

The main claim reported in the grant report is marked to be the Granted version of the main claim.



Opposition/Appeal report

Opposition/Appeal report logic is similar to Grant report, but the claim is marked to be Re-granted version.
